STANDING ORDER

To protect public health, and in recognition of the national emergency that was declared by the President of the United States on March 13, 2020, the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York hereby orders that:

New arrests must arrive at the U.S. Courthouses in Manhattan and White Plains no later than 12:00 p.m. for processing by the U.S. Marshal Service and Pretrial Services and presentment before a Magistrate Judge on the same date.

Nothing in this order may be construed as prohibiting the Duty Magistrate Judge from ordering that a particular defendant be admitted to the courthouse after the 12:00 p.m. deadline.
